

**Pinkham Notch, NH Snowshoe Trip Packing List**  
**SC 56**  
**January 5-7, 2018**

**Please bring these items to the meeting on Tuesday Jan 2 for the pack check. If you do not have any of the items you will be able to borrow them. Be sure to check in w/Mr English or Liz so that what you need will be on the AMC list.**

**Required Items**

- Winter hat (wool or synthetic), covers ears, too
- Winter outerwear – wind and water resistant, insulated coat (with a hood is best)
- Rain suit – top & bottom
- fleece or wool pants
- 2 Fleece jacket (synthetic) or heavy wool sweater
- 2-3 Pairs heavy wool socks
- 2 pairs of liner socks (not cotton)
- Insulated winter Hiking boots (Sorrel-type)
- Balaclava and/or neck gaiter or scarf
- 2 pair wool or fleece mittens (mittens are better than gloves)
- 1 pair insulated, water-resistant over-mittens
- 2 sets Synthetic/wicking long underwear (base layer) top and bottoms – NOT COTTON
- Underwear (preferably synthetic)
- 1 pair boots/alternate footwear
- 2 wide mouth water bottles (e.g. Nalgene) – with insulators
- Sleeping pad
- Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, include lip balm)
- watch – not on a cell phone
- 1-3 bandanas
- Sleeping clothes – cotton is OK for Friday night
- Sunglasses/goggles
- Headlamp or flashlight
- Scout/Venture handbook
- 2 large, heavy duty trash bags
- Pack to carry it all in
- 0 degree rated sleeping bag (most of these will be borrowed from the AMC).
- Mess kit (insulated mug/cup and spoon is all that's really needed) everything else is provided onsite)

**Optional Items**

- Camera
- Book to read
- Pocketknife
- Earplugs
- hiking poles
- Gaiters

Please do not bring electronics & devices.
