

COVID protection protocols for Troop 56 trips 2021-2022 Season

Testing:

Testing is not required but If the participant tests positive in the past 2 weeks, either via pool testing or individual test prior to the trip, they will not be able to attend the trip

Transportation:

Carpooling will be allowed for trips under the following conditions:

- 1) The number of passengers will not exceed the design capacity of the vehicle
- 2) All riders will wear masks during the journey
- 3) Passengers should not eat while in the car.
- 4) It's recommended to have windows open/cracked during the trip.
- 5) No more than one unvaccinated passenger per car.

Camping, hiking or other outdoor activities:

Unvaccinated scouts should camp in single tents. Vaccinated scouts can tent singly if parents request

While in camp, hiking or participating in other outdoor activities as their own group, masks shall not be required and participants can choose to wear a mask.

If the Troop is joined by outside leaders or instructors, or Scouts from other troops, masks shall be required of all participants for the duration of the collaboration.

Dining, resting, education or other indoor activities:

Troop 56 activity participants shall wear masks during all indoor activities, unless seated at dining tables and actively eating.

Ineligible to be Vaccinated:

- 1) Should be provided with single tents
- 2) Not more than one per car unless riding with family members
